



ACTIVITIES AND TASKS

1. To acquire a physical space that would allow for the proper running of the Home FELICITAS (from the state or local government).
2. To seek collaboration from unions and construction companies to improve the building acquired or to build a structure if a lot is acquired.
3. To gather the professionals that volunteer to be part of the team: a pediatrician and nutritionist, as well as the following professions: social work, psychology and counseling, teacher, lawyer, childhood specialist who can also run a team of young professionals.
4. To provide training to teachers, professionals and other volunteers in a way that shares the spirit of the association beyond the theoretical and practical expertise.
5. To design the institutional educational project and to establish house rules and rules for the functioning of the Home.
6. To relieve the availability of some members, especially teachers, and to be the people who live with the children or who are employees who work directly with the children.
7. To establish agreements with educational institutions, clubs, libraries, and other non-profit organizations in the community that can welcome the children who live in the home and offer them other opportunities for development and socialization.
